### FIRE or MEDICAL EMERGENCY

If a **FIRE** or **MEDICAL EMERGENCY** occurs, call **911**

When contacting 911 be prepared to provide the following:

- Your name
- Type of emergency (fire, medical emergency)
- Building address
- Your location within building (floor #, parking garage)

Do not hang up until the 911 operator requests that you do so. Provide the Resident Manager (685-2331) with the same information given to the 911 operator as soon as you are able.

If **FIRE** or **SMOKE** is detected:

- Close all doors to the fire/smoke area.
- Activate the fire alarm / manual pull station at nearest stairwell.
- Call 911 from a safe area after evacuating the area.

If an **ALARM** is activated:

- Leave the building immediately.
- Use the stairways only to exit, staying to the right.
- Proceed to the assembly point at the front of the buildings on Bonaventure Avenue.
- Do not re-enter until the Fire Department or the building Fire Marshall gives the “all-clear” signal.

If a **FLOODING** situation occurs:

- Do not touch electrical equipment.
- Move to a safe area.
- Call the Resident Manager (685-2331).
- Contact 911, if necessary.
